# Training Students for Their Inheritance

The rainy season has finally come to Thailand! Thailand and Burma had been going through an unusual drought. It seems the moment we stepped on the plane back to the U.S., the rains started! That is good news for us as we planted a fairly large garden by our home, our lot is quite large. The garden should be ready to help feed our students, in the fall.

As for the students, we were sincerely blessed by the quality of students that we had this past spring. We were blessed by the work effort they put into the classes as well as the practical work outside of the classroom. Our goal for these students is that we, "preach Him, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus. To this end we labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily." (Colossians 1:28).

All of this takes time, patience, energy, and money and, all of this is limited but we

believe God will give us the knowledge and the wisdom to build up these leaders. Most of the time, we operated on a bicycle and a motorbike, but God is good, and someone from Thailand gave us a small pickup (1994 Toyota Hilex) to use for the ministry. Believe with us to focus on the most important items and prioritize correctly. We consider this an honor to minister to His children and to work for the Lord and train them up in the faith. My wife, brother-in-law, sisters-in-laws and my father and mother-in-law have been a great help to me in this, and we are grateful that we can work together.

We held seminars with Peter and Colleen Jackson and Dr. Al Purvis and Dr. Ron Denotter.

On the Burma side of the border, we have continued to work on the land as the money has come in. We have completely leveled the land and put in temporary water drainage for the rainy season. Permanent water drainage may not be done until the government decides to put in a more permanent road to the village. There is lots of infrastructure that needs to be in place so some of our planning will fall in line as the roads around our land become a little more permanent.

Some of the future plans for the property include a home for children from very poor villages. Most of the children live in very poor conditions and their education is very limited (I will have more on this in the near future). Our property is

close to one of the major cities and this will benefit these children's education. We also have plans for a training center to help raise up Godly ministers for the Burmese nation (now called Myanmar). Burma needs Godly leaders and we believe God has anointed us to be part of what He is doing in Burma. If you have any interest of coming and helping us – whether it be a seminar or teaching at the training center or some kind of medical outreach – let us know. As of now, we do the leadership training on the Thai side of the border, but we can still do outreach on the Burma side of the border.
