A part of our vision is a children's home on the property in Burma – raising up children in the Lord.

This past month, my brother in-law Samuel, Sarah, and Ruthie have been helping another bible school located in Mae Sai while we (our bible school) are in recess; and the director has been very pleased with their skills. But they still meet with our students on a regular basis to teach them English and music. Our school year will begin again in September.

donated \$5000 for the completion of our wall around the Burma property. That leaves a little more than \$2000 left for the completion of the eastern

side of the wall. Our goal of having a bible school and children's home on the Burma side of the border lives strong in us and we are grateful for all of you that have continued to support us.

As for the property in Burma, we ask that you believe with us concerning the first children's home building which will be around \$35,000-\$40,000. The kitchen/dining area, which is about 6 meters by 12 meters, will be close to \$8,000; the shower/laundry area will be 6 meters by 15 meters, which will also serve as showers and a toilet facility will be close to \$12,000.

Believe with us to continue to make an impact with the Bible students and a future children's home.

Thank you all for you continued help with your continued prayer and support.
