# Summer Months

During the summer months (March and April), our children return home to their parents for a few weeks before the school year starts again. Our children come from very poor villages and poor families where the children are not able to get an adequate education. Our staff speaks at least 3 languages as well as English. This year, we may be taking in an additional 5 or 6 children. But to do this we would certainly need another vehicle as the one we have now is quite old (1994 Toyota) and does not have the capacity for 16-17 children. Believe with us that we will be able to obtain a new vehicle for the Children's Home.

# Project Update

We are in the process of putting up a skills and office building. Right now we use a dorm room (each dorm building has two dorm rooms) as a chapel and one dorm room as an office. The 2nd floor of the new building will serve as a home for my family. The directors of the Children's Home my brother-in-law and his wife, will then move into the end apartment in one of our dorm buildings.

Many of you may know that my wife is pregnant and is due the end of July or early August. We have put roughly \$7000 into the new building and we would like to move to the 2nd floor by the end of May if possible. We have come quite a way on the building and would like to have the roof on before the rainy season. The total cost of the building is roughly \$38,000 and completing the 2nd floor is the most expensive part of the building because of the roof. Believe with us to be living on the 2nd floor by the end of May.
