one of the reasons we hold regular children outreaches on our compound. In the middle of July, we had an outreach to our village area and kids from another children's home as we played games and ministered the gospel to them and their parents!

PROJECT UPDATE

We have finished the cement fish pond and we will be stocking it with catfish. Our goal is that this will help with some of the costs of feeding our 18 children as well as family and staff members. This will also help teach the children an additional skill of raising fish. We will still be raising some mountain pigs. The native mountain pigs are much easier for us to take care of and the children like the taste of pork, whether it is a special breed or a native pig.

We have made great progress on the office and skills building this past month and I am believing God that by the first week of September, the second floor of the building will be complete and furnished. The first floor will be used as a temporary chapel and for the kids to do their homework and develop skills. Eventually the building will be used to teach different skills and well as media. Right now we are using our kitchen area, which is made of bamboo and a tin roof, for worship and study.
