These past few weeks where our children's home is located was flooded with rain that devastated the community of Tachiliek, Myanmar. Fortunately, our children's home is located on higher ground and our drainage system is designed for a proper run-off. But the rain was way beyond what we could have imagined. One of our two bamboo buildings collapsed, but nobody was injured. But our neighboring villages and community experienced devastation beyond what one could imagine. Our Bible Students and our children responded with physical help, food and prayers. Because of YOU... (our partners) our new Heavy Load Tricycle was loaded up with food along with our truck. Our Father God wants to show forth His presence through the good works of his children and by the GRACE of God we were ready to respond. The world has been experiencing troubling times everywhere and the body of Christ is rising up everywhere showing that OUR GOD IS ABLE TO OVERCOME all that comes against us. The scripture tells us that, "My soul, wait silently for God alone, for my expectation is from Him." Psalms 62:5.

The Bible School training has continued in the midst of much of the crisis in Burma. This past week we sent them out to begin the harvesting of our rice field. Our Bible students do it the old-fashioned way manual labor. This is going to be a boost for us because of the soaring food and rice prices. With all the planting of our gardens and the harvesting of the rice field the students are having plenty of work to do as well as helping all the people during the flood that hit our area.
